AAUW of Cobb County members should be proud of our contributions and the branch received \$8900.00 in proceeds.

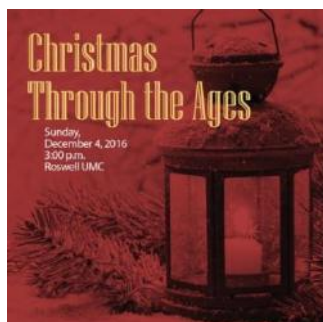
